




## **OUR DEFINITION OF STUDENT SUCCESS**

2016 FIRST TIME ENTERING % RETURNING IN 2017




2017 FIRST TIME ENTERING % RETURNING IN 2018




### **GRADUATE EMPLOYABILITY: TRENDS FROM 2011 - 2017**







## THROUGHPUT RATES OF ALL UNDERGRADUATE QUALIFICATIONS 2017


3- AND 4-YEAR DEGREES AND DIPLOMAS (2012 COHORT)




# **GRADUATE OUTPUTS PER FACULTY 2017**


